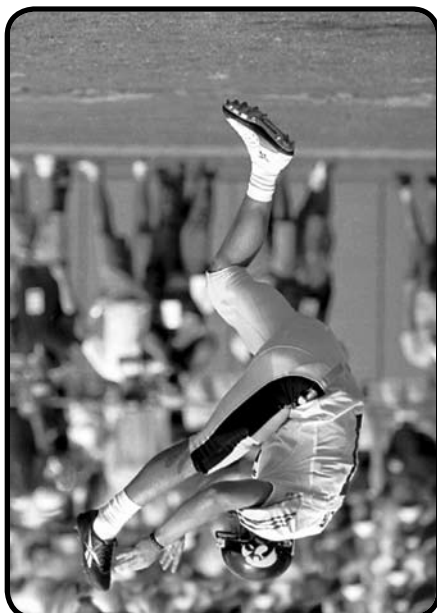

Special Teams Camp Staff: Former Hawkeye Special Teams Greats



Jason Baker 1997-2000

Iowa's record holder for career punts (272) and career punting yards (11,304 yds.). He has a career average of 41.6 yds. He ranks 2nd in the Big Ten for career punts and yards. Baker has punted 3 of Iowa's 6 longest punts. He was the special teams MVP for the 1997 Norwest Sun Bowl. Baker is a four-time letter winner.



Nate Kaeding 2000-2003

As Iowa's single season (120 pts.) and career (367 pts.) leading scorer, Kaeding rewrote the Hawkeye record books while accomplishing 1st team All-Big Ten and All-American honors in both 2002 & 2003, twice named a Lou Groza finalist as the nation's best kicker, winning the award in 2002. After playing a vital role in the Hawkeyes return to national prominence, Kaeding was drafted by the San Diego Chargers as the first kicker taken in the 2004 NFL Draft.

Joel Hilgenberg 1980-1983

At Iowa, Hilgenberg was voted 2nd Team All-American offensive line. He was a four-time letter winner. The New Orleans Saints drafted Hilgenberg in 1984. He played from 1984-93 for the Saints. He was a multiple NFL All-Pro selection.



Rob Houghtlin 1985-1987

As a three time letter winner at Iowa, Houghtlin set long standing records as single season and career leading scorer. Defined by clutch game winning kicks, Houghtlin was named the place kicker on Iowa's all-time team. Houghtlin was one of the first in a long line of walk-ons that developed into all-Big Ten performers, a Hawkeye tradition.

CAMP GOAL:

All registration forms must be received by June 5, 2009.

ELIGIBILITY: All campers that are entering grades 11 and 12 next fall are eligible to enroll. NCAA regulations do not allow high school graduates to enroll.

CHECK IN: All campers need to report to the Indoor Practice Facility, which is located on the east side of the Recreation Building. Check-in will be between 8:30 and 9:00 A.M..

EQUIPMENT: All campers should come dressed to participate in the days activities. We suggest that you bring shoes that would allow you to kick on both the artificial and natural turf surfaces, plus a kicking tee & sports bag.

CAMP FEE: A **\$50.00 camper fee** covers instruction, and t-shirt. The full fee must accompany the registration form. Checks should be made out to Hawkeye Football. All cancellations must be received at least twenty days before camp begins. After the deadline, a \$30.00 fee will be deducted for administrative expenses.
