

General Information

Housing for Residents

Residents are participants who are living in one of the residence halls during camp. There are two campers per room and roommate assignments are made two weeks prior to the camp date (*Roommate requests received less than two weeks before camp start date may not be possible.*). If you have a roommate preference, write the name of the person on your application form in the designated area. Bedding, which includes sheets, pillow, pillowcase, and blanket is provided. Meals are served in the University dining facilities.

Medical

A medical form signed by a doctor or a school sports physical within one year of the camp date is required to participate, **no exceptions!!** You can download a medical form at www.iowasportscamps.com, under the forms tab. If you provide a school physical, the release of liability, medical and media authorization still needs the parental signature on the original medical form. Trainers and medical personnel are available 24 hours a day.

Items to Bring to Camp

Participants must furnish their own towels and toiletry items. Specific field hockey items to bring would be: hockey stick, shin guards, mouth guard, turf shoes/cross trainers (**no cleats**), tennis shoes, and goal-keeping equipment if you are a goalkeeper. It is a good idea to bring extra spending money for soft drinks, snacks, and apparel at the Hawk Shop. The camp administration will not cash personal checks from campers. When not in a sports session, dress is casual, so bring along your favorite jeans, shorts, summer shirts, and a swimsuit. You may wish to bring an alarm clock and a small fan. **We strongly discourage you from bringing any valuables to camp. The University of Iowa is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**

Important for Parents

Each registered camper will receive a confirmation letter along with a medical release form, after we receive your application. You can go to www.iowasportscamps.com, apply online or download all information necessary to attend camp. If you don't have access to a computer, give us a call and we will mail them to you. **NOTE: Completed and signed medical forms must be on file to participate, no exceptions.** School physicals along with our medical form signed by a parent/guardian may be used if the physical is within one year of the camp.

Transportation and Extra Overnight Stay

Transportation is available to and from the Eastern Iowa Airport (Cedar Rapids) for a \$25.00 fee. Transportation is also available to the Iowa City bus depot at no additional charge. To ensure transportation when you arrive, please fill out our travel form at least two weeks in advance (no phone calls accepted). The travel form is available on our web page under the travel tab. At the time you reserve your airport transportation, the \$25.00 fee is due. The Eastern Iowa Airport (CID) is located 30 miles north of The University of Iowa campus. Allegiant, American, Delta and United service the airport. There is an additional \$50.00 overnight fee for campers arriving one day early or staying one day after the camp has concluded. The overnight fee will include meals and room.

Health and Insurance

Costs for the treatment of injuries and hospitalization for illnesses or injuries incurred during the Sports Camps will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the participant.

Eligibility

The Field Hockey camp is for high school age athletes: those entering 9th grade through graduating seniors.

Costs and Cancellations

The fee per session is all-inclusive; there are no extra charges. A \$50 deposit is due with applications received on or before May 1st, with the full tuition due no later than June 20, 2010. For applications received after May 1, 2010 the full tuition is due with the application. Campers who must leave during the week due to illness or injury will receive a prorated refund based on the number of days room and board were required.

No refunds will be given to campers who voluntarily leave camp or who are sent home for disciplinary reasons.
