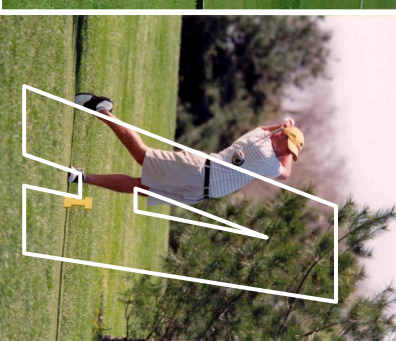
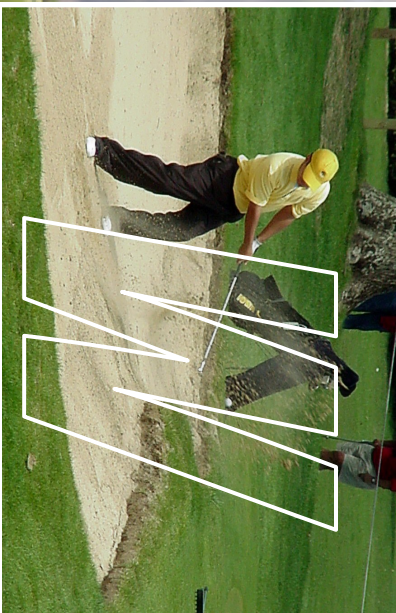
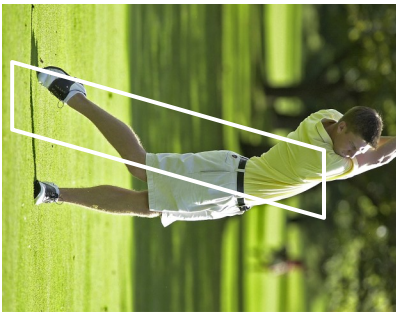

Camp Fee

The resident fee for a week session is \$750.00. This includes everything but incidental spending money. The commuter fee for the camp is \$675.00 and includes lunch, dinner, all learning sessions and evening activities.

Facilities and Lodging

Instruction and play will be at Finkbine G.C., home to the University of Iowa golf teams, with 18 holes of bent grass fairways and greens, 3 teaching tees, 5 putting greens and shortgame areas. Lodging will be at Hillcrest on the U of I campus, with dining at the Hillcrest Marketplace.

Head Men's Golf Coach, Mark Hankins, brings 22 years of golf instruction and camp experience to the University of Iowa Junior Golf Camp. With 17 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at Iowa State University, the University of Texas at Arlington, Michigan State University and the University of Iowa, Coach Hankins has led his teams to 22 collegiate tournament titles while achieving 12 NCAA appearances. While coaching Michigan State, Coach Hankins led his team to 2005 and 2007 Big Ten Championships while earning Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in each of the two seasons. Coach Hankins has also served as a teaching and assistant golf professional at various country clubs and camps including Des Moines G&CC, Ames G&CC, the Iowa PGA Golf Academy, and the Cyclone Country Golf Camp. Coach Hankins was also a collegiate standout attaining First Team Academic All-American at Iowa State in '93, Academic All-Big Eight Conference in '88, '91, and '93 and First Team All-Big Eight Conference in '93.
